**Silviu Hotăran** started his career in Microsoft as a General Manager of Microsoft Romania in 1996, when the subsidiary was opened. In 2004, Silviu Hotăran was appointed general manager of Microsoft South-East Europe, and has been responsible for the overall Microsoft business development in ten countries in the region.
