Mr. Ioan Andone was born on 1 November 1947, in Dragomirești, Neamț County. An alumni of the Alexandru Ioan Cuza University of Iași (class of 1971) and of the Graduate School of Business at the University of Pittsburgh, PA, USA (class of 1977), Mr. Ioan Andone obtained his PhD in 1985.

In 1971, Mr. Ioan Andone has started his university career at the Faculty of Economics, within the Alexandru Ioan Cuza University, Iași, first as assistant professor (1971 - 1974), then as associate professor (1974 - 1994). Since 1994 he holds a professorship at the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration.

Mr. Ioan Andone is a PhD advisor since 1999, having had 22 PhD candidates under his guidance, from which 12 have already earned the degree.

He has published 37 books and courses, 179 scientific papers or studies, being an active member in more than 20 scientific research projects.

Professor Ioan Andone has made a number of study and work visits at: Universite Paris-Dauphine, Universite Paris XI (France, through a TEMPUS grant awarded in 1994-1995); Essex University (United Kingdom, 2002); City University of New York, Zicklin School of Business, Baruch College (New York, USA, 2000); St. John's University (New York, USA, 2001); Pisa and Roma (Italy, 2002); University of Bilbao (Spain, 2007).

Throughout his career, he has also been entrusted with the following positions within either the university, or in various boards of associations, foundations and other institutions:

- Director and founder of the research group on "Intelligent Systems in Economy";

- Member of the INFOREC Association since 1996;
- Organizer of the international symposiums "European Excellence in Business Studies Students' Education" - 2000, "InfoBUSINESS" - 2002, 2004, 2005 and "KnowledgeBUSINESS" - 2003;
- Expert-evaluator for the CNCSIS program;
- Expert-evaluator for the CEEEX program;
- Reviewer for the conferences "EISTA" in 2005 - 2010, "InfoBUSINESS" in 2006;
- Reviewer for the journals "Informatica Economica" and "Journal of Applied Quantitative Methods";
- Member of the national editorial board of "Review of Economic and Business Studies";
- Member of the editorial board of "Broad Research in Artificial Intelligence and Neuroscience";
- Member of the advisory board for the "Journal of Applied Quantitative Methods".

Professor Ioan Andone has remarkable contributions in the fields of Intelligent Systems, Expert Systems, Accounting Information Systems, Knowledge Management and Enterprise Modeling.
