Mr. Victor-Valeriu PATRICIU was born on 25 June 1951, in Timisoara district, Timis County. An alumni of the Politehnica University of Timisoara, Computer Engineering Department, class of 1975. Mr. Victor-Valeriu PATRICIU obtained his Magna cum laude PhD in 1993 at Politehnica University of Bucharest, Computer Engineering Department, thesis: "Security of Distributed Systems and Computer Networks; A Software Toolkit for Generating Cryptographic Services for Networks and Distributed Systems".

Mr. Victor-Valeriu PATRICIU started his university career in 1979 in the Computer Engineering Department from Military Technical Academy, first as teaching assistant between 1979 and 1985 then as associate professor from 1985 to 1995. Since 1997 to current he works as professor at the same university.

Mr. Victor-Valeriu PATRICIU was a PhD adviser from 1997 in Military Technical Academy Doctoral School of Electronic, Informatics and Communication Systems for Defense and Security, in Computer Science & Information Technology domain. He is official doctoral supervisor (Ph.D.) students in Computer Science & Engineering.

Professor Victor-Valeriu PATRICIU in visiting/associate professor at Politehnica University, Bucharest, Academy of Economic Studies Bucharest, BRIE- Bulgarian-Romanian Inter-University Center of Europe, Titu Maiorescu University, ENSIETA Brest, France, Institute National Polytechnique, Toulouse France.

Mr. Victor-Valeriu PATRICIU developed an excellent scientific cooperation with Romanian Military Resource Management Center, Brasov, and Institute for Advanced Technologies, Bucharest. He has published 15 books and courses, 70 papers in the last 10 years on the security informatics area.

Mr. Victor-Valeriu PATRICIU has significant scientific contributions in computer science area, especially in security informatics. Professor Victor-Valeriu PATRICIU has remarkable contributions in the fields of Information Security developing, deploying and auditing, electronic signatures and PKI, Biometrics, Cyber defense, Ad-hoc networks, IDS, honeypots systems, cloud security, etc.

He is a person with a highest professional level, he developed scientific research teams in the field of applied security informatics in economy, and he is a very rigorous and exigent person. The academic community from computer science area appreciates very much his professional qualities and entire activity.

For all these remarkable results, the selection committee decided that the 2013 Grigore C. Moisil award goes to Professor Victor-Valeriu PATRICIU.
